REPORTS TO Nutrition Manager

JOB GOAL Works in a safe, sanitary, and time efficient manner to produce meals for students and completes duties as assigned by the manager.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

1. Cups all fruit/desserts on menu for the day
2. Assists with salad bar preparation
3. Assists with wrapping meats/sandwiches on menu for the day
4. Assists with preparation of breakfast items for the next day
5. Monitors lunch line during lunch service
6. Assists with replenishing food as needed on the line
7. Works in dish room as scheduled
8. Cleans up assigned work area: sweeps, mops, wipes down work tables
9. Other duties as assigned by manager

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

Must be able to lift 40 pounds without assistance and on occasion repetitively. Work in a fast paced environment and stand for extended periods of time. Other physical demands that may be required are as follows:

TEMPERAMENT (Personal Traits)

1. Adaptability to perform a variety of duties, often changing from one task to another of a different nature without loss of efficiency or composure
2. Adaptability to accept responsibility of the direction, control or planning of an activity
3. Adaptability to deal with people beyond giving and receiving instruction
4. Adaptability to make generalizations, evaluations, or decisions based on sensory or judgmental criteria

CAPACITY AND ABILITY REQUIREMENTS

Specific capacities and abilities may be required of an individual in order to learn or perform adequately a task or job duty.

1. Intelligence: Ability to “catch on” or understand instructions and underlying principles and ability to reason and make judgments
2. Verbal: Ability to understand meanings of works and the ideas associated with them
3. Numerical: Ability to perform arithmetic operations quickly and accurately
4. Data Perceptions: Ability to understand and interpret information which may be presented in the form of graphs, charts, or tables

Normal working environment and moderate exposure to extreme temperature changes
